Administrative Council Highlights – January 2, 2024

The Ad Council met by Zoom conference on Tuesday, January 2, 2024 with seven people present. The following items were discussed:

- Nurture, Outreach and Witness
 (NOW). The NOW Committee did not
 meet in December, but would get together
 by Zoom on January 15.
- Trustees. The Trustees were to hold their first meeting of the new year in person in the Fireside Room on January 9, largely to elect officers. Tom has authorized an electrician to reposition the security camera that is currently located inside the Fireside Room kitchen.
- Staff-Parish Relations Committee. The job description for the new part-time youth director position is just about done and we will soon post it online and at local colleges, as well as with an online service that Tom's company has used successfully for many years.
- Financial Report. The General Fund collections for December were \$15,911.19, plus \$11,150.00 that was transferred from the Designated Fund for our 2023 apportionments. Paid expenses were \$25,403.00, including \$13,150.00 paid for apportionments. The checkbook balance was \$5,360.34 as of December 31, with unpaid bills totaling just under \$1,700.00.

Gregg said apportionments paid to date were 8.32% of our 2023 income, and about \$2,650 more would need to be paid by January 12 to reach the 10% target. Ivoni commented how important it was for us to make the full 10% payment, and she and Gregg pointed out this is one of the factors that the Conference apparently takes into consideration when reviewing

grant applications. Ivoni noted that our recent grant of \$5,000.00 from the Central Valley District for part of the cost of our new youth director position. In December we submitted a request for \$20,000.00 for the additional annual cost we are incurring for a full-time pastor instead of the 75% assignment that we had for several years.

- Calendar of Events for 2024. In order to avoid time conflicts and increase their chances of success, the Ad Council discussed developing a master calendar of events for the year. Tentative plans included resumption of the baked potato luncheon and the Fall Festival dinner, along with rummage sale(s) and a luau. Ivoni suggested establishing a fundraising committee to focus on scheduling those types of events.
- Parish Care. Prayers were requested for Kimery, Guadalupe, Dan and Karen Bonillas, Charlene, Jean Willis, the people afflicted by the earthquake in Japan, and areas involved in armed conflict, specifically Ukraine and the Middle East.
- Pastor's Report. Ivoni thanked the entire church family for the work accomplished in 2023, and said she was looking forward to an even better year in 2024. She mentioned some potential ideas for future activities for our church, including a Moms' Bible study; a men's group; social activities for all ages, including mid-week events; offering our church as a safe place for after-school activities; and providing transportation for youngsters to attend youth group

Ivoni invited suggestions for any other programs or events that we could attempt.

• Other Business. Effective July 1, we will have a new District Superintendent, as David Niu is being transferred to the Los Rios District.
