Administrative Council Highlights – February 6, 2024

The Ad Council met by Zoom conference on Tuesday, February 6, 2024 with eight people present. The following items were discussed:

- Nurture, Outreach and Witness (NOW). The NOW Committee met on January 15 and had no major problems with a request by LB Memorial Hospital to use our Fellowship Hall kitchen in August and September while major work is done at their kitchen. Ivoni did some outreach with food and drink for local homeless people. No dates have been set for the rummage sale, but VBS will be the week of June 17-21. Roxanne will be away for much of February so there will be no Sunday school for about a month. Lori wants to hold a weekly craft evening. Susan Younce will provide the initial last Sunday after-church lunch, on February 25. NOW meets next on February 19.
- **Trustees.** Chris Foxworthy will fix some items in the parsonage soon. The oven in the Fellowship Hall will be checked as one side reportedly does not fully heat up. The Trustees will meet in person on February 13, with a Zoom option. The security camera that was in the Fireside Room kitchen has finally been relocated, giving a much better view of the class-room wing. Our contract with Comcast for phone and internet service expires in March, and we will switch to AT&T, which now has faster, cheaper fiber optic cable service available to our church site.
- United Women in Faith. The women meet on February 8 to share a soup and salad lunch and a white elephant gift exchange. The next meeting is March 14.
- Staff-Parish Relations Committee. We received over 15 applications for part-time youth director, but unfortunately, none of

them appear to have any experience with children or church activities, so SPRC is pondering its next steps.

- Financial Report. The General Fund collections for January were \$13,808.23, and paid expenses were \$15,121.86, leaving a checkbook balance of \$1,098.46 as of January 31, with unpaid bills totaling \$494.08. After the January 2 Ad Council meeting, Gregg directed Cathie to make a payment of \$2,700 for our 2023 tithe to reach the 10% goal for the year, trusting that collections would continue to be as good as in December and January. The state's minimum wage increased from \$15 to \$16 per hour on January 1, resulting in a wage increase for one of our employees.
- Upcoming Events for 2024. Ivoni will meet with a small group to consider dates for social, educational and fundraising events for the year. Ivoni is planning two silent services on Ash Wednesday, from noon to 1:00, and from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. Written instructions will be provided for individual silent prayer and meditation in the sanctuary, followed by her serving communion and imposing the sign of the cross. She is also working on suggestions for daily or weekly prayers during Lent.

- **Parish Care.** Prayers were requested for Diane Moon, Jean Willis, Kimery, Guadalupe, Ted, Fay Davis, Dan and Karen Bonillas, Charlene, and several members of Ivoni's family.
- **Pastor's Report**. Ivoni has been visiting or calling several members of our church family each week, including Jean Willis, Carl and Jolanda, Don and Carley, and Eileen Sorensen. For the shut-ins, she generally serves communion. She asked to be made aware of anyone else who could use a visit from her.

A NOTE FROM THE FINANCE COMMITTEE

Over the past few weeks, our church has benefited greatly from two extraordinarily generous financial gifts.

First, Wilma Ditter, who passed away on October 18, 2023, named the United Methodist Church of Los Banos as a major beneficiary of her will. As a member of our church for about 30 years, and Collections Secretary for at least half of that time, she knew how important it was for the church to have adequate funding to perform its mission. Since she had no relatives nearby, in many ways we served as her family, and she loved us just like family. As a reflection of that love, and as directed by her will, Wilma's estate recently gave a **\$25,000.00** check to the church, which has come at a crucial time for us. We have many fond memories of what she did for us for so long, and now have yet another reason to be thankful for having had Wilma as a member of our family for so long.

The second large gift, which we received in late February, was an unexpected donation of **\$5,000.00** from The Morning Star Packing Company in support of our Vacation Bible School. As many of you may be aware, VBS benefited for nearly ten years from \$5,000 annual donations from Roberta Howard and her estate. This has enabled us to present our highly-acclaimed program for children from all over Los Banos at no cost to them. We were informed last July that the Howard family's \$5,000 donation would unfortunately be the last, as the estate's funds have now been depleted. In light of this, Hans Younce, a retiree of Morning Star, applied on behalf of our VBS for a community grant from Morning Star – and it was approved last month! We are very grateful to Morning Star and to Hans, and we now have enough funds on hand for our VBS program in 2024 and 2025. There's a little more to the story (you can ask Susan Younce for details), but this has been a real answer to prayers, and a further indication that God works in mysterious and wonderful ways!
