Dear Los Banos UMC Family,

The season of *Lent* has been described as a season of reflection and self-examination for the followers of Jesus. Furthermore, Lent has been described as a season of *fasting*, which traditionally is the act of willfully abstaining from eating food in order to focus on one's relationship with God. **The important part of fasting, whether it be refraining from food or something else, is that it is an act of making space for God in our lives.**

One of the ways we can make space for God is through being in community and fellowship with one another. Beginning in the first week of March we are planning to start two **Life Groups** for *Women* and *Teachers/Parents with Children (Pre-K to 12)*. **The mission of this ministry is to create a space for individuals to explore how the amazing grace of God is changing their hearts, their lives, and their relationships with other people.** There will be six sessions, and each session will be an hour long. **Administrative Council Highlights –  
February 1, 2022**

The Ad Council met by Zoom conference on Tuesday, February 1, 2022 with eight people present. The following items were discussed:

- **Update on Proposed Los Banos Warming Center in Fellowship Hall.** The District and Conference approved the proposed two-day trial run to use our Fellowship Hall as an overnight warming center. We distributed flyers informing neighborhood residents of the plan; some were in favor and some were not. Our insurance carrier will extend coverage only if men are housed separately from women and children. That might involve using the NA/AA room, but there are many concerns about that. Henry said he would do some further work on the plan and bring the proposal back to the Ad Council at a future meeting.

Ongoing problems with homeless people and their belongings on church property were discussed at length. We are trying to get the City Police and Code Enforcement Officer to help in controlling the situation. Henry has gotten suggestions from some of his colleagues. This topic will be brought back later to the Ad Council.

- **Nurture, Outreach and Witness (NOW).** Amanda will take some time off from Manna duties. Manna is still waiting for the promised donation from the hospital, so the bank account is basically depleted. Amount from Hospital should come in March. Henry will work on a grant application for money that the District has available. Manna has not been serving many people lately, and there have also been very few volunteers. Their next meeting is scheduled for February 21, and an effort will be made to revitalize and reorganize Manna, and establish a sharing of duties between the participating churches, so we aren't always responsible.

Vacation Bible School is tentatively set for the week of June 20 through June 24. Tawny is teaching children's church during the month of February. Scout Sunday is coming up on February 13.

- **Trustees.** The parsonage fence repair has been completed. Some roof leaks have been successfully fixed at the church. The new security camera near the kitchen door of the Fellowship Hall has been installed, but the internet connection needs to be upgraded before we can monitor the site. The termite-infested wooden pole behind the classroom wing has been removed. A locking mechanism has been purchased and will soon be on the bin, and Cassie has asked the waste company about a green yard waste can.
- **Financial Report.** The church's income for January was \$10,256.07, paid expenses were \$10,570.45, and the checkbook balance on January 31 was \$3,018.64.
- **Staff-Parish Relations Committee.** The SPRC is updating job descriptions for all of our employees, to better reflect the work that each of them actually does.
- **People in Need; Parish Care.** Prayers were requested for Susan Ramsey, Cathie Lopez, the Walsh family, Wilma Ditter, Amanda, and the family of Bonnie and Ted for a recent death in the family.
- **Pastor's Report.** Henry said he was working on the annual statistical report to the Conference for the Dos Palos church; Cassie and Gregg were taking care of the reporting for Los Banos. He was also preparing for an interview on February 17, which was a required step for him to be ordained as an Elder. He advised that he would be out of town for a couple of days, on February 13 and 14. He thanked all who had covered for him on January 23 – especially Juli Rice, who gave the message – when he unexpectedly needed to miss church.
